

411 E. State Street:


- Secured pledge from owner to gift 411 E. State Street

Monument Plans

Current State of Play

- We intend to build the Monument Plaza at 411 E. State Street within two years.
- The Monument Plaza will include a giant wall resembling the original façade of 411 E. State Street
- The Monument Plaza will have a series of walls that will narrate the historical significance of 411 E. State Street





Monument Plans

- We estimate that the cost to build and maintain the monument to be \$3.6MM
- \$1.5MM for construction
- \$2.1MM maintenance & operations

Let's realize the dream of Jewel Founder Henry Arthur Callis who said:


